KEY CONCEPT/ DISADVANTAGE	Respect
OBJECTIVES	 to help children recognise that decisions driven by anger or revenge can have unintended consequences that affect not just one person but the whole group to teach children the importance of admitting mistakes and taking responsibility for their actions to help children learn how to manage frustration and anger in healthy ways, rather than acting impulsively to encourage children to consider others' perspectives, communicate openly, and find fair solutions to conflicts instead of seeking revenge

QUESTIONS FOR DISCUSSION FOR POSITIVE ENDING

- Why do you think Eva decided to admit that she hid Adam's coat?
- How do you think Adam felt when his coat was missing?
- What would you do if you were in Eva's place?
- Why is it important to be honest, even when we are afraid of getting into trouble?

- to encourage children to consider others' perspectives, communicate openly, and find fair solutions to conflicts instead of seeking revenge
